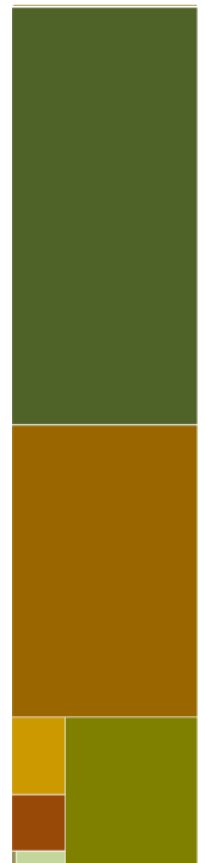

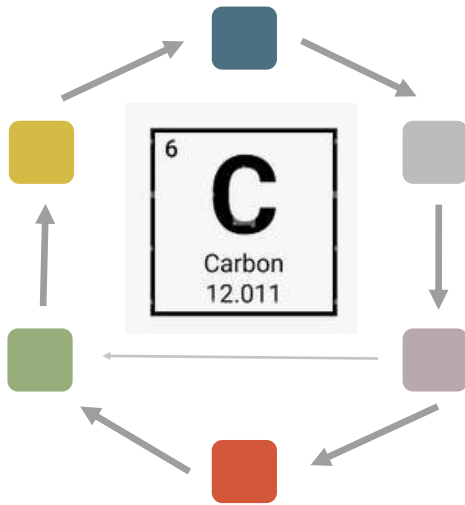

We design to eliminate future waste by considering longevity, ease of repair and maintenance, flexibility, adaptability and reusability with an aesthetic that’ll stand the test of time. This way, all the carbon we are storing in our furniture and within your building can stay exactly where it is

Building Blocks

We have a small list of carefully selected main materials which go into our products all sourced from local British distributors or manufacturers.. We have an open approach to our material and chemical use

Laminate

Extra Thick 3mm compact grade laminate with Greengard Gold and Indoor Advantage Gold TM. accreditation

Plywood

Birch Plywood covers most of our plywood needs. A Strong, sustainable product with the best in class for low formaldehyde emissions - CARB2 TSCA Title VI compliant

Timber

Sustainably sourced, (FSC on request) small selection of beautiful timbers

Steel

Our metal brackets are designed by us and manufactured here in the UK from British steel

Paper

Post-consumer recycled paper which is recyclable

Finishes and Glues

All finishes and glues are water based and once cured and on site give off minimal to no VOC’s

On the tools

We operate the workshop and office on 100% renewable electricity. Our small offcuts are burned on site for reducing our gas usage on heating and our finishes are hand applied

Most timber offcuts are re-used on smaller items and laminate offcuts are used underneath bench seat pads. Any remaining waste is controlled via 3rd party waste streams where they are separated for recycling where possible

Let’s go

Distribution is a large consideration when your thinking about your environmental impact. It inevitably effects your products from the design stage. We have some major boundaries to cross over the coming years to improve our standpoint on this, For now we are doing everything we can do to minimise our impact in the UK and Europe by consolidating deliveries, and using local companies who will use less miles and can return our packaging. All American orders are shipped via road and sea freight

Water and cloth

Our products are freestanding and can be installed, broken down, and re-installed with simple hand tools. They require only a damp cloth for upkeep and a light Hoover of the soft seat pads

The Afterlife

Our design philosophy focuses much more on longevity and craftsmanship. We rarely ever get requests for repair or return of products due to faults. Our end of life hope is that the furniture finds it’s forever home. This is our dream, but the reality may differ. If a product is no longer needed it can be returned to us for re-sale. It may get a little spring clean, but we will avoid adding additional carbon miles at all costs. If it is in unsalable condition for any reason, we will break down and re-use or recycle as many components as possible
